

Prescience Camp 2

At this camp, trainees will hone their abilities of prescience in order to find the path to the next camp. Trainees will have to divine a passphrase according to these rules:

1. The passphrase is made up of two English passwords.
2. About once every 10 seconds, trainees may ask a yes-no question about one of the passwords, e.g. "Is the first password an object?" or "Does the second password contain vowels?"
3. The answer to your question will be encoded according to a certain rule, i.e., answers that mean "yes" all have something in common, and answers that mean "no" lack that commonality. The rule is different for each password.
4. If a question cannot be answered unambiguously, no answer will be given.

When trainees think they have figured out the passphrase, they may whisper their guess, and will be shown the way to the next camp if they are correct.
